The first international conference "International Online Conference on Application and Progress of Interpersonal Psychotherapy in Treating Adolescent Depression", approved by the Ministry of Education, was successfully held online.

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The online international conference "International Online Conference on Application and Progress of Interpersonal Psychotherapy in Treating Adolescent Depression " was successfully held on July 9-10, 2022, organized by the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine and co-organized by Zhejiang Society for Neuroscience, and Psychological Consultation and Psychotherapy Industry Association of Zhejiang Province. This is the first international conference that is approved by the Ministry of Education in this discipline.

The conference invited 45 domestic and international experts from the US, UK, Canada, Hong Kong, and mainland of China to participate in a variety of activities including keynote lectures, seminars and case studies. Over 160 participants attended the conference. The conference covered communication and practice in multiple sub-areas, with 20 keynote lectures on various topics. By building an international platform for the exchange of frontier information and research advances, this conference looks forward and contributes to comprehensive decision-making in the psychological treatment of adolescent depression.

Professor Hu Shaohua, director of psychiatry department, the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine, and Professor Huang Manli, deputy director of psychiatry department, the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine and president of the Chinese Chapter of International Society for Interpersonal Psychotherapy, co-chaired the conference.

The conference started at 8:00 a.m. on July 9. Chairman and chairwoman of the conference introduced the addressing speakers: Professor Lu Lin, academician of Chinese Academy of Sciences and director of Peking University Sixth Hospital; Professor Liang Tingbo, secretary of the party committee of First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University School of Medicine; Professor Luo Jianhong, former vice principal of Zhejiang University and chairman of Zhejiang Society for Neuroscience; and Professor Xu Yi, president of Psychological Consultation and Psychotherapy Industry Association of Zhejiang Province.

Zhejiang University School of Medicine, gave a great speech to the opening of the conference. He welcomed the experts and participants. He spoke highly of Professor Huang Manli and Professor Hu Shaohua, who contacted the founder of IPT, Professor Myrna Weissman, and introduced IPT into China and facilited its development. They carried out relevant training, education, scientific research and clinical application, and established the Chinese chapter of International Society for Interpersonal Psychotherapy, with Professor. Huang Manli as the first president. Professor Liang Tingbo said they not only made great contributions to psychotherapy, but also started a new wave in the Chinese psychotherapy profession.



Professor Lu Lin, academician of Chinese Academy of Sciences and director of Peking University Sixth Hospital, emphasized in his speech that adolescent mental health is an important public health issue that cannot be ignored. Professor Huang Manli has been promoting the development of IPT in recent years in collaboration with many domestic experts. They translated treatment manuals, conducted a series of trainings and trained Chinese interpersonal psychotherapists. All of these have played a very important role in promoting the development of IPT. Academician Lu Lin expressed his high recognition to experts in the field of mental health and psychology from all over China.



Professor Luo Jianhong, former vice principal of Zhejiang University and Chairman of Zhejiang Society for Neuroscience, stated that this conference not only expanded the influence of IPT, but also promoted the integration of basic neuroscience research with neuropsychiatric diseases, which built a new environment and created new opportunities for clinical conversion applications. Adolescents are the future of the country and healthy psychological and personality developments are the foundation for their growth and success. It is highly necessary to provide safe and effective depression interventions for adolescents.


Professor Luo compared this conference to a cornerstone to provide more professional technical tools for depression intervention for adolescents.



Professor Xu Yi, president of Zhejiang Psychological Consultation and Psychotherapy Industry Association and former director of psychiatry department of The First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine, said that IPT is an internationally recognized treatment method with reliable research and clinical evidence. He recognized that the introduction and application of IPT in the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine will substantially promote the development of psychological counseling and psychotherapy. The industry association will also continue to support and actively promote the communication and dissemination of IPT in China.



Hosted by Professor Xu Yi, the first two sessions of the conference were presented by Professor Myrna Weissman, founder of IPT and current president of the International Society for Interpersonal Psychotherapy, and Professor John Markowitz of Columbia University. Professor Myrna Weissman gave a speech on development of IPT over the world. Professor John Markowitz talked about IPT as an evidence-based therapy and the development of ISIPT. Associate Professor Wang Zheng of psychiatry department, the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine, served as the simultaneous interpreter.



Myrna Weissman (USA) Development of IPT Over the World





During July 9 to July 10, IPT experts introduced the framework and techniques of IPT for each of the three stages. Professor Li Weihui first introduced the initial stage of IPT, Associate Professor Liu Guangya introduced the middle stage, and Associate Professor Hu Jianbo introduced the termination stage. In the three thematic seminars, psychotherapists Wang Zhong and Hu Chanchan from the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine provided three detailed case demonstrations. Professor Luo Yanli, Chen Qiaozhen, Wang Zheng and Zhou Xiaoyi, commented and analyzed from the perspectives of association of emotional change and interpersonal events as well as case conceptualization and design of treatment framework. Professor Kang Chuanyuan, Zhang Lujia, Hu Chanchan and Wang Zhong discussed the impact of parent-child conflict and mentalization on the efficacy of IPT for adolescents. Professor Xu Hua, Cai Wen, Tang Luhan and Chen Jingkai, talked about the impact of relationship ending on adolescents' emotions and conversion strategies for poor treatment outcomes. As the conference went on, participants became more and more enthusiastic and formed a good learning atmosphere.


